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PER COURT :-

1. The petitioner is aggrieved by the order of the Additional Divisional Commissioner, dated 28.8.2017, with reference to the mutation entries.
2. The petitioner has an efficacious statutory remedy of filing a second revision, in the light of the judgment of the Honourable Apex Court in the matter of Gurudassing Nawoosing Panjwani Vs. State of Maharashtra (2016) 2 SCC 213].
3. Learned Advocate for the petitioner submits that the time spent by the petitioner in this Court may be considered as a ground for condonation of delay.

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4. As such, this petition is disposed off. The petitioner at liberty to avail of the above stated remedy. If the revision is preferred within one month from today, the time spent by the petitioner in this Court from 1.11.2018 until one month from today, would be a good ground for seeking condonation of delay.
