Per Court:

1 At the request of the learned advocate for the petitioner, the second Writ Petition No.13368/2019, which was not on the board, was also called for and taken on the board, to be heard along with the first Writ Petition No.13241/2019.

2 The learned advocate for the petitioner was heard for quite some time on the grounds raised in both the petitions. He submits that Regular Civil Suit No.47/2012 (old Special Civil Suit No.65/2009) is posted for final arguments. All the grounds permissible in law may be kept available to the petitioner to be raised in a regular civil appeal, if the suit is decided against him by the Trial Court.

3 In view of the above, both these Writ Petitions are disposed

off.

4 Needless to state, if the petitioner suffers an adverse judgment of the Trial Court, all grounds permissible in law are kept open to be raised while filing the Regular Civil Appeal.
