PER COURT:-

1. Leave to correct the names of respondent nos. 6 and 7.
2. Heard Shri Rathi, the learned counsel appearing for the applicant and Shri Londhe, the learned counsel appearing for respondent nos. 1 to 7. Respondent no.8 though has been duly served, none has caused appearance on his behalf.
3. For the reasons stated in the application, delay of 14 days caused in filing the appeal is condoned. The CA for condonation of delay is disposed of. The appeal be registered in accordance with law.
