PER COURT:-

1. Learned counsel for the applicants undertakes to remove the office objections. The ld. Counsel submitted that, inadvertently the office objections were not removed and in the circumstances the order dt. 10.09.2018 was passed by the ld. Registrar, dismissing the writ petition in default.
