PER COURT:-

1. The present writ petition is an abuse of the process of Court. The petitioner is transferred from unaided to aided division with effect from 01.12.2019. The proposal is submitted by the Management on 03.12.2019 and the petition is filed on 04.12.2019 seeking direction against respondents.
