2. We have heard the learned Counsel for the applicant and
perused the averments made in the application seeking extension
of time of four weeks to comply with the order dated 21.2.2019
passed by this Court. It is submitted that before granting any

the Director of Survey and Land Records and Technical Section
of the Municipal Council would be required. Statements made
