The Applicant has impugned the decision taken by the Goa State Milk Producers Union Limited in the meeting held on 9th April, 2018 declaring the Applicant as disqualified. The Writ Petition filed by the Applicant has already been admitted.

It is however made clear that the appointment, if any, made by the Respondents would be subject to the outcome of the petition. If any appointment is made, a copy of the decision shall be furnished to the Applicant by the Respondents. It is made clear that we have not expressed any views on merit of this matter. All contentions of both the parties are kept open.

4. The Civil Application is disposed of on the aforesaid terms.
