In Crime No. 219/2018 registered with Jaysingpur Police Station, Dist. Kolhapur for offence punishable under Sections 307, 395, 397, 120-B 195-A, 342, 323, 427, 504 and 505 of the Indian Penal Code, applicant is seeking pre-arrest bail.

2 Upon perusal of F.I.R. and other documents, *prima facie* it appears that the victim i.e. complainant has suffered simple injuries.

3 There is no specific role attributed to the applicant of active

participation in the crime in question but for the threats issued.

4 That being so, application for grant of pre-arrest bail is made out. Hence, following order:

(A) In the event of arrest of the applicant in Crime No. 219/2018 registered with Jaysingpur Police Station, Dist. Kolhapur, applicant be released on bail on furnishing P.R. bond in the sum of Rs. 25,000/- with one or more sureties in the like amount.

(B) Applicant shall not influence witnesses or tamper with evidence.

(C) Applicant shall attend the Investigating Officer on 08/02/2019, 11/02/2019 and 13/02/2019 between 10.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon and thereafter as and when directed.

(D) Applicant shall co-operate with the investigating agency.
