1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioners.
2. None for the respondents though the respondents are duly served. The petitioners are aggrieved by the order dated 26.10.2016 passed by the Trial Court below Exhibit 53. The petitioners are the original plaintiffs. An application was made by the plaintiffs on 24.7.2015 below Exhibit 53 for framing additional issues. The Trial Court passed the following order :-
