

3. By the said order dated 12th June, 2019, all that we have asked the Joint Charity Commissioner to do is to hear the application dated 27th July, 2018 and dispose of the same within a time frame. This order is thus innocuous not giving any further directions than to dispose the pending application. We do not have any reason to recall such direction. There is nothing in the order to prejudice or restrict the rights and contentions of either side. Surely, the application which is pending before the Joint Charity Commissioner, must be decided and disposed of in accordance with law.

4. The Review Petition is, therefore, dismissed.
