C.J.S.D., Ichalkaranji is transferred to the Family Court at Solapur and will be heard and disposed of by the Family Court Solapur in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible in any case before 31.12.2020.

2. Respondent Husband had agreed to withdraw the pending HMP NO. 167/2017 filed u/s. 9 of Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 in the Court of C.J.S.D., Ichalkaranji.

3. Both the parties have agreed to co-operate for disposal of the HMP NO. 177/2018 and will not seek adjournment on flimsy grounds.

4. The abovesaid Misc. Civil Application No. 62/2018 is disposed of in above terms with no order as to cost.”
