. Respondent No.1 complainant is present in the Court. She accepts the Consent Terms which are recorded in Petition No.A-915/2016 by the Family Court at Bandra. It appears that accordingly the petitioner before this Court has deposited amount of Rs.30 Lakhs with that Court on 15/12/2018.
