1] This is an application for relaxation of condition No.4(b) imposed upon the applicant while granting him bail by this Court by its Order dated 5th July 2018. The said condition No.4(b) reads as under:

3] In view thereof, the said condition No.4(b) is modified to the extent that, the applicant is hereinafter directed to attend the Sahar Police Station once in three months i.e. on every first Monday of the third month till conclusion of trial.
