2. Heard Mr. Malik, learned Counsel for the petitioner. Respondent No.1 appears in person. She has tendered photocopy of her PAN Card, which is taken on record and marked 'A' for identification.

3. This matter is moved by way of praecipe dated 17.01.2019 for withdrawal of the Petition. Mr. Malik states that petitioner is present in the Court.
