2 Applicant is seeking regular bail in Crime No. I-206/2017 registered with Sinnar Police Station, Nashik for offence punishable under Sections 366(B), 368, 372, 373, 376(2)(n), 376(d) r/w 34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 5 & 6 of the Immoral Traffic (Prevention) Act and under sections 3(1), 4, 8, 16 and 17 of the

Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012.
