2. By this First Appeal, the appellant/original claimant is challenging the judgment and award dated 20/04/2016, passed by Railway Claims Tribunals, Mumbai Bench, Mumbai in Claim Application No.OA(IIU)/MCC/2010/0122 rejecting appellants' claim application under Section 16(1) r/w Section 13 (1-A) of the Railway Claims Tribunal Act, 1987, and Section 124-A of the Railways Act, 1989, seeking compensation to the tune of Rs.4,00,000/-.
