

Application. Learned Counsel for the Applicant submits that they have good chance of success in the present case. She submits that the Hon'ble Court may please be condoned the delay in filing the Appeal from Order.

5. On the other hand, learned Counsel Ms. Panday for the Respondent vehemently opposed the present Civil Application. She submits that the Applicant has not shown sufficient cause for condonation of delay in filing the Appeal from Order. Hence, there is no substance in the Civil Application and same be dismissed.

6. Considering the submission made by learned Counsel for the Applicant and reasons disclosed in paragraphs 4 and 5 of the Civil Application, I am satisfied that the Applicant has made out the case for following order:

- (i) Delay of 26 days in filing the Appeal from Order is condoned.
- (ii) Civil Application is disposed of accordingly.
- (iii) No order as to costs.
