This Writ Petition has been listed on 24 prior occasions. On 30<sup>th</sup> April, 2012, the advocate for the petitioner sought time and it was granted. Since there was personal difficulty, the adjournment was granted. In the absence of the petitioner and his advocate, on 17<sup>th</sup> January, 2013, notice was

issued on this Petition returnable on 22<sup>nd</sup> February, 2013. Notice was directed to be issued to 4<sup>th</sup> respondent, but the advocate for the petitioner showed no interest in paying process fees/bhatta charges. He did not remain present before the Registry (Judicial).
