- 2. Leave encashment amount to Rs.2,83,280/- pm 05/06/2012*
- 3. General Provident Fund amount to Rs.5,17,488/- on 29/06/2011*

4. *All five instalments of arrears of 6th pay commission are also given to the petitioner after his retirement in October 2012*
5. *After the order of Hon'ble High court dated 7/02/2017 monthly pension is regularly disbursed to the petitioner.*

All above benefits are given to the applicant. In fact Sr.No.1 to 4 has been paid before the direction of Hon'ble High Court"
