1. Heard Mr.Kaustubh Kandpile, learned counsel for the applicants and Mr.C.D.Mali, learned AGP for respondent No.1.

2. This application has been filed for restoration of the related writ petition, Writ Petition No.9277 of 2017 which was dismissed for non-prosecution pursuant to order dated 16th January, 2018 of Registrar Judicial-I.

3. Writ petition was dismissed on the ground of petitioner not taking appropriate steps for serving respondent Nos.8 to 11.
