1. Learned counsel for the petitioner and respondent nos. 1, 2 and 4 state that the parties have arrived at a workable arrangement. Parties are present in Court. They tender consent terms dated 25th February, 2019 signed by petitioner and respondent nos. 1, 2 and 4. Consent terms taken on record and marked "X" for identification.
