ORDER IN CIVIL APPLICATION NO. 2960 OF 2018 :-

. By this application, the applicant has sought to condone the delay of 160 days in filing the first appeal against the judgment and award dated 18/07/2017 passed by the MACT, Vasai in MACP No.28/2014.
