2 By this Civil Application, Applicant is seeking stay of the operation and implementation of the impugned judgment and award dated 30.06.2015 passed by learned 2nd Joint Civil Judge, Senior Division, Alibag at Raigad in L.A.R. No.623 of 2000.

3 The learned A.G.P. for the Applicant

submits that as per order dated 3.4.2017 passed by this court they already deposited entire awarded amount in the Reference Court, Statement is accepted.

4 The learned counsel for the Respondent Claimant submits that they also preferred Civil Application No.296 of 2019 for withdrawal of the amount. He submits that that Application be decided on its own merits.

5 Considering the submissions made by the learned A.G.P. for the Applicant and as entire amount is deposited in Reference Court within time, I am satisfied that the Applicant has made out a case for allowing the present Civil Application. Hence, following order:

A) Civil Application is allowed in terms of prayer clause (b) which reads thus:

"b) that this Hon'ble Court be pleased to stay the operation, execution and implementation of the Judgment and Award dated 30.06.2015 passed by the Learned 2nd Joint Civil Judge, Senior Division, Alibag-Raigad in L.A.R. No.623 of 2000 (Old L.A.R. No.269/1990), till the hearing and

final disposal of the above mentioned
First Appeal."

B) Reference Court is directed to invest the entire amount in fixed deposit of any nationalised bank initially for a period of one year and same be continued till further orders.

C) Civil Application No.296 of 2019 preferred by Claimant be decided on its own merits.

D) Civil application stands disposed off accordingly.

E) No order as to costs.
