1. Report of the Registrar (Judicial II) is received.

4. The matter is to be proceeded on a day to day basis. The learned Counsel for the accused and also the learned Prosecutor to cooperate with the learned Judge, without taking any adjournment in the matter hereafter and thus, it shall be concluded on or before 31.5.2019.
