1. By this petition, the petitioner is challenging the order dated 29th December, 2017, passed by respondent No.2-Corporation, under which, the petitioner is kept under suspension pending disciplinary enquiry.

Mr. Bukhari, learned senior counsel for the respondents, makes a statement that subsequent to the passing of the impugned order, disciplinary enquiry was initiated against the petitioner and same is concluded also. The petitioner participated in the said enquiry. The petitioner thereafter was given notice to show cause as to why his services should not be terminated.
