Learned Senior Advocate for the Petitioners states that the Petition may be permitted to be withdrawn for the reasons the Petitioners intend to make a representation to the Respondent No.3 concerning allotment of the Free Symbol : “Whistle”. Counsel prays that directions may be issued to the Respondent No.3 to decide the representation within two days from receipt thereof.
