This is an Application under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for bail in CR No. 5 of 2018 dated 6th August, 2018 registered with Juhu Police Station, Mumbai under Sections 406, 420 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

2 Heard the learned counsel for the Applicant, the learned counsel for the first informant and the learned APP. Perused the charge-sheet.

3 During the course of arguments, the learned counsel for the Applicant, on instructions, submitted that, the Applicant without

prejudice to his rights and contentions and with a view to prove his bonafide will deposit a sum of Rs.29,87,492/- in the Registry of this Court within a period of one week from the date on which the present Order is uploaded on High Court Website. The said statement is accepted.

4 In view thereof and without going into the merits of the matter, the Applicant can be released on bail.

Hence the following order-

- a) The Applicant be released on bail in CR No. 5 of 2018 dated 6th August, 2018 registered with Juhu Police Station, Mumbai on his furnishing PR bond of Rs.15,000/- with one or two local sureties in the like amount.
- b) It is made clear that, the deposit of the said amount of Rs.29,87,492/- in the Registry of this Court shall be condition precedent for the actual release of the Applicant from the Jail.
- c) After his release from Jail, the Applicant shall attend all the dates before the Trial Court unless

exempted by the concerned Court.

- d) Any two consecutive defaults in complying with the afore-stated condition will attract the provisions of cancellation of bail.
- e) Application is allowed in the aforesaid terms.
