3. By this application, applicant is seeking condonation of 114 days delay in filing first appeal, challenging judgment and award dated 22.9.2014, passed by the Railway claim tribunal, Bombay in O.A.No293/2009.

4. Considering the submissions made by learned advocate for applicant, reasons disclosed in civil application, I am satisfied that applicant has made out a case for allowing this application.

5. Hence, the following order.

a) Delay in filing first appeal is codoned.

- c) If all office objections are removed, matter to appear on board on 12.7.2019 for admission.
- d) Civil application stands disposed of.
