1] Heard for some time. The grievance of the petitioner is that a Transfer Deed has been registered in her absence. A photograph affixed on the said Transfer Deed is not of her and the thumb impression thereon is also found to be of somebody else by Forensic Document Examiner.

2] The petitioner has already filed a Special Civil Suit No.150 of 2016 and obtained the orders protecting her possession.

3] Learned APP pointed out a communication dated 20th August 2018 sent by the Police Constable attached to Vasai

Police Station to Office of PP, which shows that then enquiry being made.

4] We are not inclined to adjourn the matter further.

5] If photograph on the registered Transfer Deed is not of the petitioner and the document does not bear her thumb impression, the respondents ought to have proceeded further in accordance with law.

6] Hence, with aforesaid directions to the respondents, we partly allow the Writ Petition and the same is disposed of.
