Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that this civil application seeking deletion of respondent Nos.3 to 11 from the array of respondents may not be permitted as they are necessary parties to the civil revision application. However, learned counsel for the applicant in the civil revision application submits that they are not necessary parties and presses for deletion.
