1 Heard. By this petition under Article 227 of the Constitution of India the Petitioner challenges the order dated 03.01.2018 passed by Respondent No.5 by which the dispute between the parties u/s.21A of the Maharashtra Cooperative Societies Act, 1960 was remanded for fresh hearing to Respondent No.1 Dy. Registrar.

2 The main contention of the Petitioner is that the said order is passed without giving any opportunity to them to put up their case.

3 Bare reading of the impugned order shows that the Adv. Girish Thakur appeared on behalf of the Petitioner before Respondent No.5 from time to time. In view of these facts, I do not find any reason to interfere with the impugned order by which the matter is remanded to the Dy. Registrar to decide on its own merits.

4 Hence, the Writ Petition stands rejected. No order as to costs.
