1 This is an application for condonation of delay in filing an appeal challenging Judgment and Order dated 13/12/2018 passed by the Addl. Sessions Judge, Gr. Mumbai in Sessions Case No. 299 of 2010. The delay is of 40 days. For the reasons assigned in paragraphs-2, 3 and 4, the delay of 40 days in filing an appeal deserves to be condoned in the interest of justice. Hence, the application is allowed in terms of prayer clause (a) and stands disposed of accordingly.
