2. By this Application, the Applicant seeks relaxation of the Order dated 28th December, 2018 passed by this Court (Coram: Bharati H. Dangre, J.) in Anticipatory Bail Application No.2713 of 2018.
3. Learned Counsel for the Applicant states that vide the aforesaid Order dated 28th December, 2018, the Applicant was granted pre-arrest bail and the applicant was directed to appear before the Investigating Officer, once in a week and on any other dates whenever called by the
