1] This is an application for relaxation of condition No.(C) imposed upon the applicant by this Court while releasing him on bail.

The said condition reads as under:-

“After availing the bail the applicant, shall attend the CID (Crime) Pune Police Station between 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon on every first Monday of the month till the conclusion of the trial.”

2] Mr.Redekar, the learned counsel for the applicant submitted that, the applicant had sincerely complied the said condition for last about five years. He further submitted that,

the trial is commenced and few witnesses have been examined by the prosecution. It is therefore submitted that, the said condition may be modified in the interest of justice.

3] In view of the above, the applicant hereinafter is directed to attend the CID (Crime) Pune Police Station on every first Monday of the third month, i.e. four times in a year, between 10:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon till the conclusion of trial.
