

would automatically lock the TP address. In the case of the Petitioner, this is precisely what has happened. He would point out that one once instance, the Petitioner had filled the said details after nearly 120 hours, hence the system has blocked TP address. He however stated that to get the TP address released, the Petitioner has to approach the concerned Commissioner with proper representation and upon being satisfied that all necessary details have been provided, the TP address can be unblocked by the Department.

3. We wish these details were provided by the Department to the Petitioner, which possibly would have avoided the Petitioner approaching the Court. Be that as it may, if the Petitioner approaches the Respondent No.2 with details in a representation within a period of seven days from today and providing the necessary material in support of its stand that all details as required, though belatedly, as of now have been provided, the Respondent No.2 shall consider its representation within a period of 14 days and pass a final order within such time. If Respondent No.2 needs any clarification, the Petitioner would be put to notice. With these directions, the Writ Petition is disposed of.
