By this application, the Applicant seeks quashing and setting aside of the order dated 15th June, 2019, passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, City Civil and Sessions Court, Greater Mumbai, inasmuch as, it directs the applicant to deposit an amount of Rs.7,63,500/-, within a period of 10 days, in the Registry of the trial Court.
