3. By this Civil Application applicant is seeking condonation of 3 years 235 days delay in filing First Appeal challenging the judgment and award dated 20.09.2005 passed by Civil Judge, Senior Division, Barshi, Dist. Solapur in Land Acquisition Reference No. 668 of 2002.
