This matter is moved by way of a praecipe dated 5.4.2019 for withdrawal of the petition on the ground that the parties have filed consent terms dated 28.1.2019 for divorce by mutual consent in Marriage Petition No.A.235/2013 before the Family Court at Thane. In pursuance thereof, the learned Judge, Family Court at Thane has passed decree on 15.3.2019 dissolving the marriage between the parties by mutual consent under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short, 'Act').
