- 1] Heard learned counsel for the appellant and respondents.
- 2] It is submitted by learned counsel for the appellant that this Appeal is preferred by the appellant against the refusal of ad-interim relief, vide it's order dated 05.08.2015. Thereafter this Court has granted ad-interim relief by it's order dated 06.08.2015. The same order is continued till today.
- 3] In view thereof, it is submitted by learned counsel for appellant and respondents that as the Notice of Motion is yet pending before the trial Court, this Appeal can be disposed off by directing the
