for modification of the interim order passed by this Court.

2. Today, when the matter was heard for some time,
learned Counsel for the Management on instructions would
submit that they may be permitted to make an appropriate

application to respondent No.3 – the Joint Director of Higher Education, Pune as it is now his submission that the post on which the respondent is working is entitled to receive grants.

3. Liberty to the Management to make such an application. If such an application is so made, learned AGP states that the same would be decided expeditiously. This is without rights and contentions of the parties that in a challenge to the order of College Tribunal, such a plea by the Management is not permissible. The application, if any, made by the Management to be decided by Joint Director of Higher Education on its own merits expeditiously.
