2. By this Civil Application, Applicant is seeking condonation of 62 days delay in filing First Appeal.

3 The learned counsel for the Respondent submits that they filed Affidavit-in-Reply

opposing the present Civil Application. He submits that Applicant has not shown sufficient cause for condonation of 62 days delay. Hence, there is no substance in the present Civil Application and same is required to be dismissed with costs.
