ORDER IN CIVIL APPLICATION NO.3956 OF 2014:-

By this application, the Applicant has sought to condone the delay of 274 days in filing the appeal against the judgment and order dated 27th June, 2013 passed by the learned Member, M.A.C.T., Pune, in M.A.C.P. No.998 of 2007.

2. The Respondents have not contested the application despite due service. In the light of the reasons stated in paragraph 2 of the

application, which in my considered view constitute sufficient grounds, the application is allowed. Delay of 274 days is condoned. Appeal be registered and be listed for admission.
