1 Heard the learned Counsel appearing for the petitioner/original accused. Perused the letter dated 06/04/2017 sent by the petitioner/accused to the learned Joint Charity Commissioner, Mumbai. Averments made in the said letter *prima facie*, constitutes the imputations which can harm the reputation of the complainant i.e. respondents herein.
