2. Heard Mr. V.R. Tripathi, learned counsel for the applicants and Ms. Aditi Naikare, learned counsel for the respondents.
3. Mr. Tripathi submits that the controversy between the parties is amicably settled out of the Court. He, therefore, seeks permission to withdraw the petition. To that effect, he has filed a praecipe dated 12.3.2019, which is taken on record and marked 'X' for identification.
