1. Heard learned counsel appearing for the Parties. This Court is not inclined to interfere in the impugned orders assailed in these petitions. However, limited protection to the Petitioner is granted till 11th September 2019 i.e. the next date of hearing before the Trial Court, so as to enable them to cause appearance before the said Court. Accordingly, it is ordered that, no coercive action be taken against the Petitioner till 11th September 2019.
