

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that cross is to be allowed. The petitioner is ready to conduct the cross-examination as and when fixed by the learned trial Judge.
3. The learned counsel for the respondents opposed this Petition and submitted that the petitioner/accused remained absent on number of occasions and prays for costs.
4. The matter is pending since 2014 and hence it is to be expedited on or before 31st August, 2019. The order of No cross and further two orders of rejecting the Application for No Cross are set aside subject to payment of Rs.5000/- to the complainant which can be paid directly in the Court to the complainant.
5. Parties to cooperate the trial Court and the trial Court to proceed with the matter. The petitioner/accused hereafter shall not remain absent on any date unless the permission is sought before hand.
6. Writ Petition is allowed.
