By this application the Applicants have sought to condone the delay of 12 days in filing restoration application and has further sought restoration of application No.1228 of 2015, which was dismissed for non compliance of conditional order dated 20th July, 2016.

2. By order dated 20th July, 2016 the Applicants were given two weeks' time to supply copies. The Applicants were put to notice that the civil application would stand dismissed without further reference to the Court in the event the copies were not furnished within the stipulated time.
