2. By this application u/s 24 of C.P.C., applicant/wife is seeking transfer of Marriage Petition No.178/2018, filed by respondent/husband u/s 13(1)(ia) of Hindu Marriage Act, for divorce before Civil Judge Senior Division, Thane to Civil Judge, Senior division, Satara.

3. In first session, both the counsel argued the matter. At their request, matter was kept in the second session.

4. In second session, learned counsel for respondent no.1 submits that he received instructions by e-mail from his

client, stating that he want to withdraw Marriage petition filed by him before Laearned Civil Judge, at Thane. Same is taken on record and marked as “X” for identification.
