1. The Applicants with their Advocate and Respondent No.2 with her Advocate are jointly requesting for quashing of FIR No.67 of 2015 dated 3rd March, 2015, under Sections 354(A), 452, 509, 506(1) and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

2. The Respondent No.2 - Complainant has accordingly filed an affidavit before this Court.

3. Learned A.P.P. upon instructions has produced a communication sent by Senior P.I, Mahim Police Station, to her office. It is taken on record as Exhibit – 'A'. It reveals 5 more offences against the Applicant No.1.
