. Accused-petitioners and respondent no.2-complainant are present with their advocates. They jointly request for quashing FIR No.161/2018 registered at C.B.D. Belapur, Navi Mumbai Police Station. Offences there are under section 408, 379 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code and also under sections 43, 65 and 66 of Information Technology Act.
